

Dear members

We are moving to Level 3 alert from midnight tonight until midnight 17th February (Wed), there are very clear restrictions and guidelines published by the Government for how to behave at level 3, here is a link for your reference. <https://covid19.govt.nz/alert-system/alert-level-3/>

As these guidelines at this stage are for just a short period, we will be closing the clubhouse facilities and on course facilities to all and we will be cancelling all tee bookings that are currently in the system for the next 3 days.

As we did last time round we will close the course to visitors. Members will be able to play but

1. Only in groups of 2 (household member bubble) or on your own. To ensure you are on your own please ask Angela via the shop number to close off the second tee slot.
2. Off Tee #1 only
3. Cards will not be printed or available
4. Please use your Dotgolf app & the Covid 19 app for booking on course.
5. With tee times spaced 10 minutes apart.
6. Please arrive just before your tee time and leave immediately after your round to ensure there is no potential for close contact to happen on course.
7. Please follow strict personal hygiene protocols- carry hand sanitiser.
8. At risk players (such as those over 70) may need to take extra measures to protect themselves.
9. The Clubhouse, pro-shop, practice nets and toilets will be closed. This includes the toilet on course next to the 7th Tee.
10. There will be no carts available
11. There will be no pins on greens and the cups will be turned upside down to ensure no contact inside the cup is required.
12. There will be no bunker rakes, ball cleaners or drinking water taps.
13. There will be no competitions running.
14. Players must maintain a minimum distance of at least two metres between themselves and other players on course who are not in their bubble.

We ask that because this is only for 3 days that you limit your booking to a maximum of two rounds across these days so that everyone can get a turn. We also ask that you only play with one ball. This is to ensure that all players get the opportunity to play and the pace is not slowed

Thank you for taking the time to read this, we hope that if everyone follows the guidelines and does their best to think of others and the long term consequences ignoring the rules could lead to, we should get through this period well.
